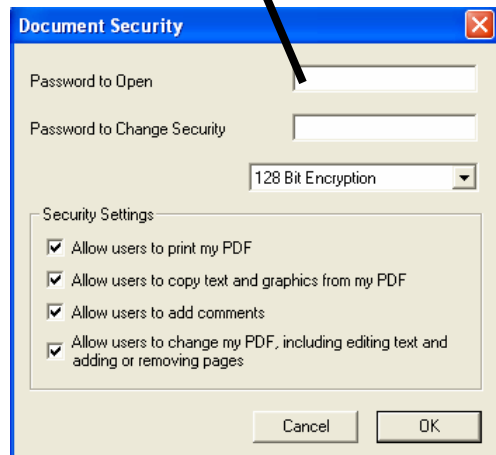
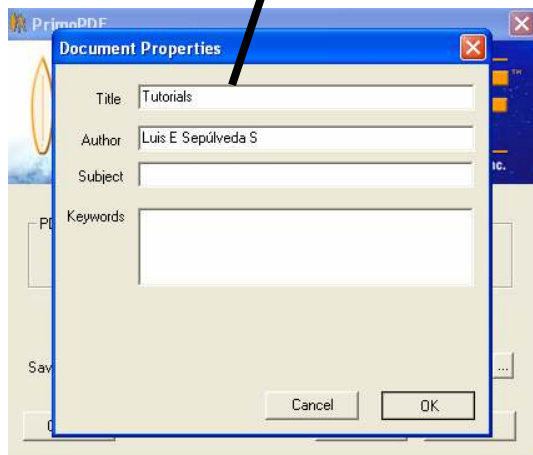
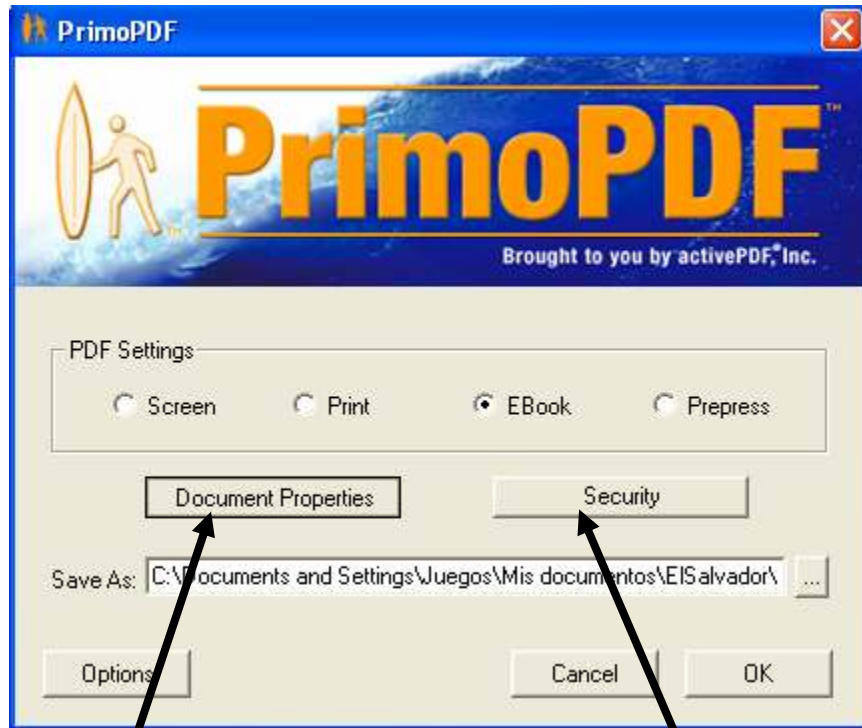
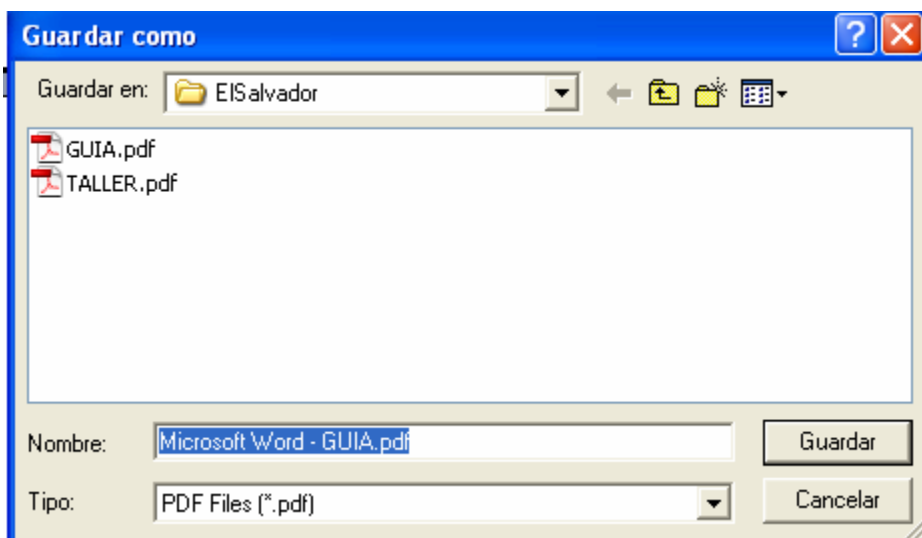


## PDF Converter

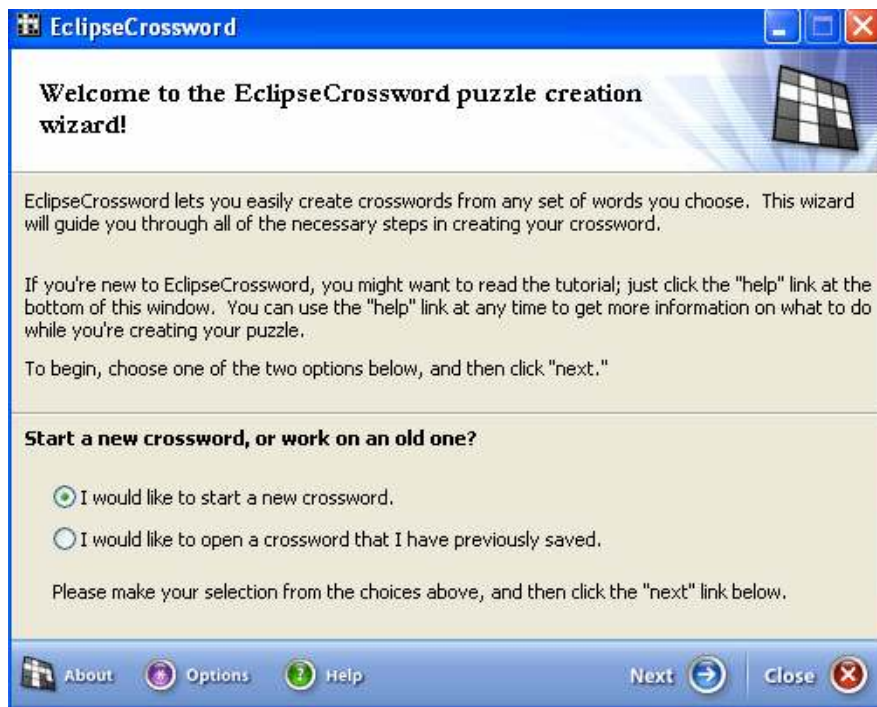
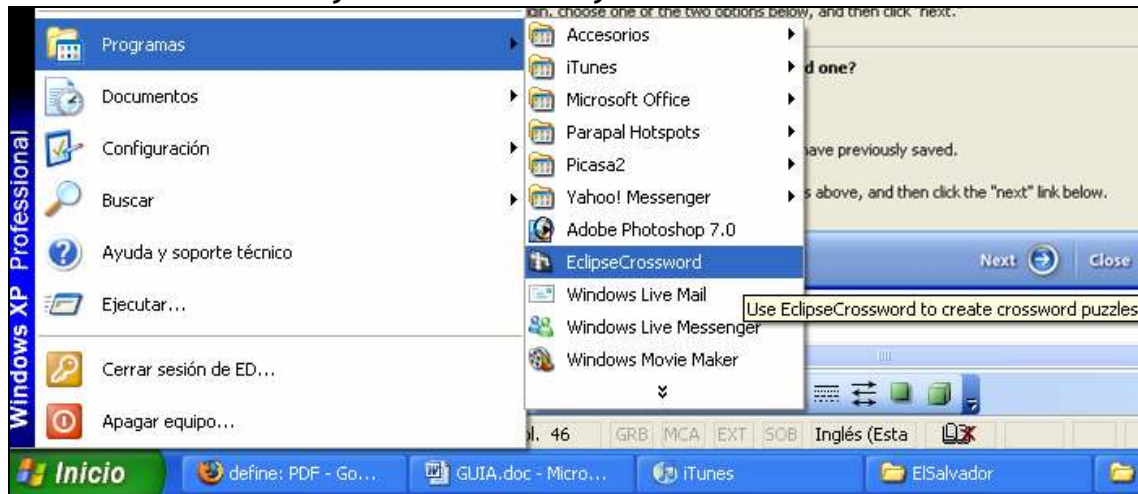
PDF: (Portable Document Format). A format from Adobe that enables a document to be distributed on different systems while preserving the layout, fonts and other graphical elements.



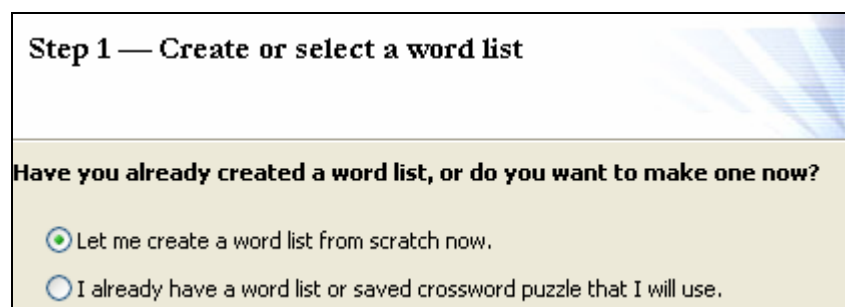


## EclipseCrossword

EclipseCrossword is a free program that lets you easily create crosswords from any sets of words you choose.



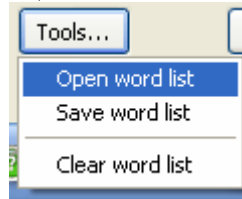
**Start a new crossword / Open an existing crossword.**

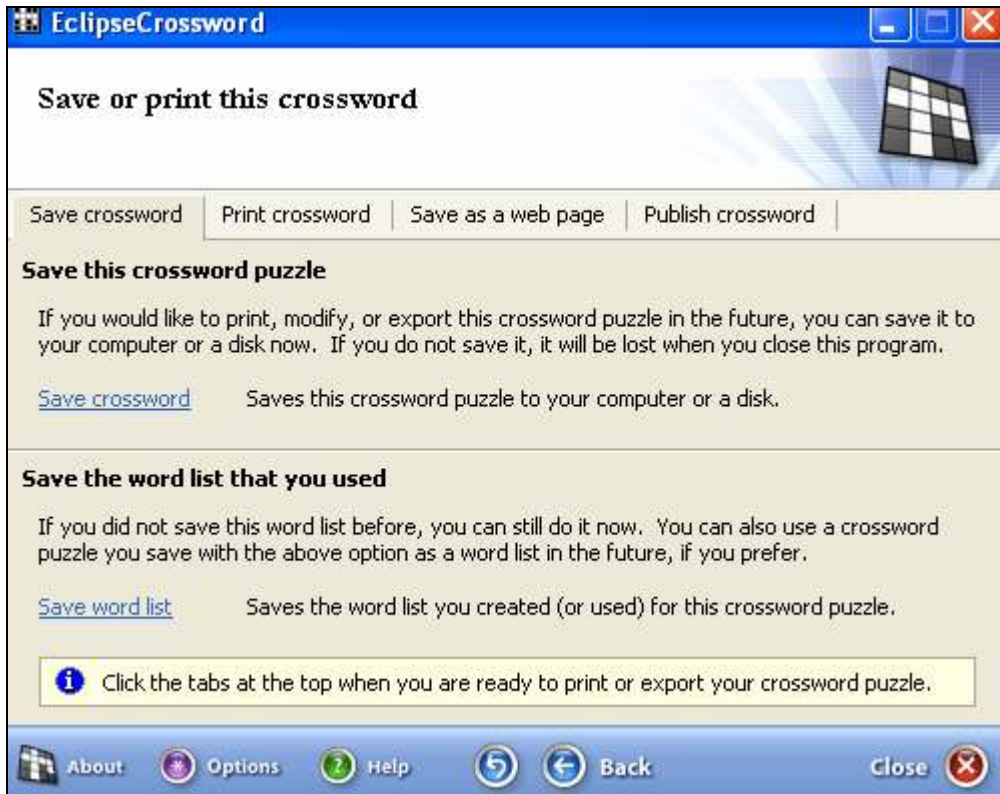

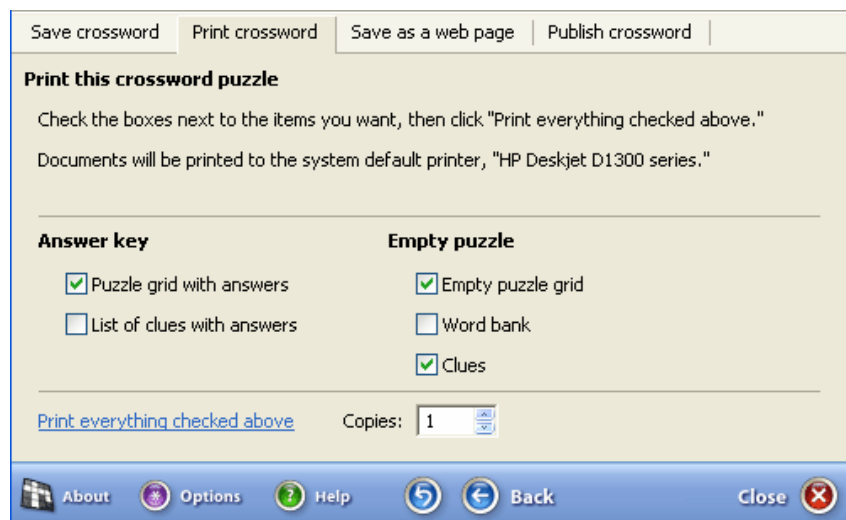

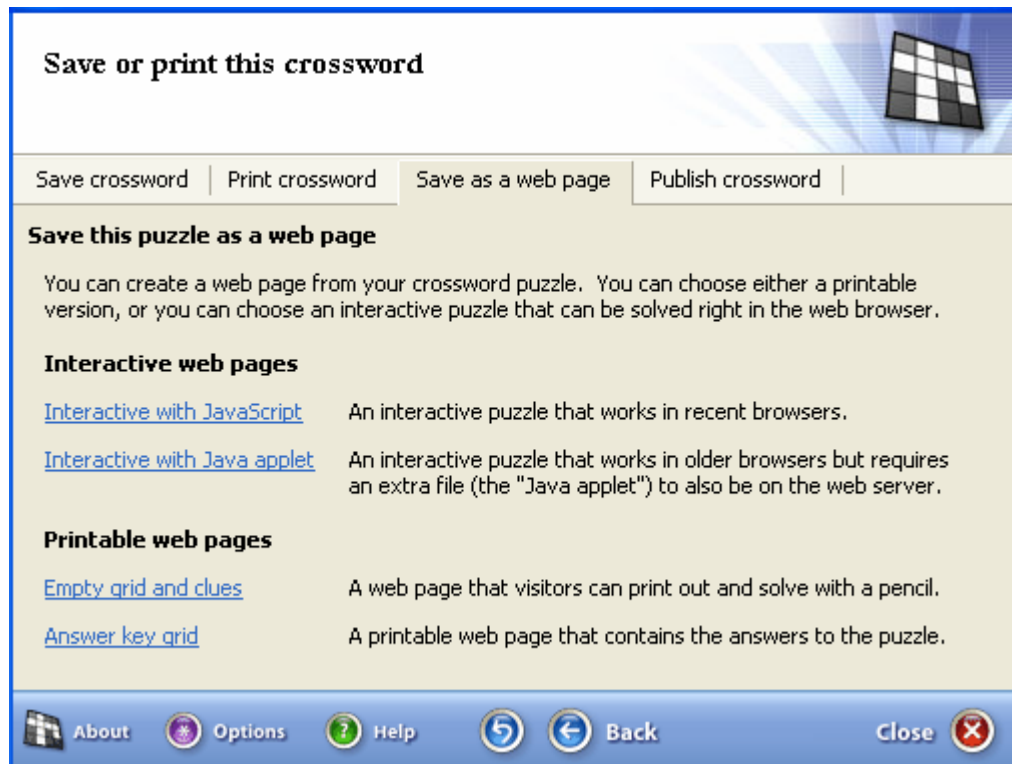


### Choose how to save it:

**Save crossword tab:** You can save the crossword puzzle you just finished, as well as the word list, if you did not save the word list when you created it. Usually, it is not necessary to save the word list, because you can use an existing crossword puzzle file in place of a word list – EclipseCrossword will use the same words from the previous puzzle. If you want to be able to reprint or otherwise reuse this puzzle in the future, you **must** save either the puzzle or its word list!
